

SLEEVES FOR QUILTS 40" WIDE & UNDER

For quilts no more than 40 inches wide we are asking that rods be supplied with the quilts. These rods, **including** the 2 screw eyes attached at the ends, should measure about half an inch shorter than the width of the quilt. We do not want the rods/screw eyes to show.



The sleeves for these quilts should be wide enough to accommodate the supplied rod, without creating a bulge that distorts the quilt. The method used for the sleeves of the larger quilts can be used, scaling down the width.

Also, if your quilt does not hang well, you may sew a second sleeve at the bottom of the quilt and include a rod (no screw eyes needed).

Ensure your name and the title of the quilt are on all rods provided.

FRAMED WORKS

For framed works, please ensure that there are 2 screw eyes securely fastened inside the back of the frame as illustrated below. This also applies to works presented on stretcher bars.
