Want to try something new?

We invite you to participate in our **Library Learning Challenge** and your name will go into a draw at the end to win one free *Sewing Together, But Apart Day*

Come to the Library at any of the fall Gatherings and here is what you'll do >

- Pick a Technique from the first bag (a list will be posted)
- You may have a 2<sup>nd</sup> chance to pick a technique if it *really* isn't what you'd like to learn or you already know how and want to learn something new
- Pick a Fat Quarter from the second bag – to be incorporated in the project you make learning this new Technique
- You can take out an 'extra' book to help you and it may also help you pick a project. (*e.g., If you already have 3 books you want to borrow and you pick Appliqué, you can add one book from the Appliqué Tag*)
- Make a gift or something for Outreach - Project size can be as small as a placemat or up to a teddy bear or lap quilt (max size 200" perimeter).
- Challenge will run from September 2023 to April 2024 – watch the Weekly email, Guild Website and Monthly Newsletter for updates

Once your "*Learning*" is finished, send a picture of it to Kathy Bissett for the next month's *Show & Share*, (by the Sunday before our Monthly Meeting) making sure you state the item pictured is for the **Library Learning Challenge**. Be sure to include what you learned. Would you use the new technique again? Easier or harder than you thought and name the book(s) that helped you.

Once the item has been shown at the Monthly Meeting, there will be one ballot with your name deposited in the draw. Entries must be received by April 14, 2024 for the April 2024 Zoom meeting. The winner's name will be drawn at the end of the *Show & Share* and announced that evening.
