From traditional to modern, using techniques such as straight piecing, paper piecing or using just one seam, Janet will take a fresh look at the small but mighty Flying Goose unit in this one-hour slide presentation.

Janet will share her extensive samples, add a few treasures from online sources and finish with her stretched and squeezed variations on 3D Flying Geese, used in many of her original designs. She invites us to "**Come and fly with her**".

In the afternoon **Joy Duke** will join us from Virginia and will share her lecture - "**Making It Your Own**" which is a presentation of how different patterns and quilts can be adapted in many ways to fit your needs or the desires of your quilting gift recipient. As Joy goes through her presentation, she shares the original pattern and then examples of how it has been changed by Joy or one of her friends/customers to add a personal touch. The entire purpose of the lecture is to encourage quilters to think of how they can use patterns they like in new ways. Joy has shared her quilts and ideas on how to adapt their patterns with quilters across the country presenting as far away as the UK.
